INFORMATION FOR PARENTS

Results In Previous Years

To help parents to interpret their children's results in the tests for academic ability and music aptitude, we publish below the lowest scores at which a place was offered on Allocation Day, in each year.

Musical Aptitude

To qualify for assessment under music aptitude, children must pass the first music test. Places are offered **only** on the basis of scores achieved in their practical assessment, or "audition" (the **second** test). 23 places (10%) are available under music aptitude in total.

Children who achieved this score or above in the written test (the **first** test) in each year were invited back for practical assessment:

The lowest scores to gain the offer of a place following the practical assessment, or "audition" (the **second** test) in each year are as follows:

Academic Ability

On Allocation Day, we offered 57 places (25%) under academic ability. These places were offered to those applicants with the highest standardised scores. The lowest scores at which places were offered on Allocation Day, in each year, are as follows:

The historical information is the lowest mark to achieve a place at that school over the last three years on Allocation Day, on or around 1st March each year. This information should be used as a **benchmark** to make a decision only about an application to a school within the Consortium.

There is no pass mark for the academic test, places being offered in accordance with each school's admission arrangements.

Once you have received your test score on Monday 17th October, you will be able to decide which school(s) you wish to apply to.

Distance

For those applicants who are unsuccessful in qualifying for a place under the tests, we publish below the farthest distances at which places were offered, on Allocation Day, under both distance criteria in each year. Those eligible will be placed in descending rank order based on the nearness of the child's permanent home AddressBase Premium address point and the AddressBase Premium address point of the School at the time applications are required.
